Call for Abstracts **2023 ABVP Symposium**

The American Board of Veterinary Practitioners (ABVP) Foundation is organizing a Poster Session during the 2023 ABVP Symposium in Baltimore, Maryland (April 20 – 23, 2023). Our goal is to create an opportunity to showcase what the ABVP membership does. Hence, we invite diplomates, residents, veterinary students (under mentorship), practitioners, academicians, and researchers to submit abstracts of novel practical studies and case reports related to one of the eleven recognized veterinary specialties within ABVP (Avian, Beef Cattle, Canine and Feline, Dairy, Equine, Exotic Companion Mammal, Feline, Food Animal, Reptile and Amphibian, Shelter Medicine or Swine Health Management).

We are looking for both research and case report presentations in poster format. A dedicated session will be scheduled in the Symposium program and presenters will be required to stand by their posters to interact with the audience. The presenting author must be registered in the Symposium.

The Foundation will cover the registration fee of all ABVP Residents that present a poster in the 2023 ABVP Symposium*

** NOTE: The call for abstracts is NOT restricted to residents. We welcome submissions from ABVP Diplomates as well as non-Diplomates from private practice, academia, government, industry or any other form of veterinary practice. However, only ABVP residents will receive complimentary registration.*

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

- Submit your abstract using the following form. Please note: you must submit in one sitting. You cannot close out of the form and come back at a later date.

- Only registered ABVP residents will receive a complimentary Symposium registration. This will be checked with the ABVP office.
- Titles should be succinct, informative, and accurately reflect the content of your poster.
- The abstract body has a limit of 300 words and should be succinct and informative. This summary should include all the relevant information of your presentation.
- The abstracts will be reviewed by the ABVP Foundation Board. Accepted abstracts will be formatted and compiled into a document that will be shared electronically with all ABVP Symposium participants.
 - *Accepted abstracts will be removed and not be allowed to be presented if the presenting author is not registered in the Symposium.*

DEADLINES

- Until **March 10, 2023**: Abstract submission.
- **March 30, 2023**: Authors notified of abstract acceptance and provided instructions about presentation.

AWARDS:

- There will be an award for the best poster presentation in each track (AVTCP, Canine, Equine, Exotics, Feline, Food Animal, Shelter) and one for the best poster presented by a resident.
- The abstracts and posters will be assessed by a panel of diplomates in good standing and other scientists.
- The award will consist of an achievement certificate and will be presented during the Diplomate's dinner.
