



## **FRENCH FELLOWSHIP FOR DVM STUDENTS**

The American Board of Veterinary Practitioners (ABVP) Foundation is pleased to announce, through the French Fellowship (<https://abvp.com/about/abvp-foundation/>), five (5) student scholarships to attend the upcoming ABVP Symposium in New Orleans, Louisiana in April 2024: <https://abvp.com/symposium/>.

Students at any level of their veterinary education at any AVMA-accredited College of Veterinary Medicine located in the U.S. or Canada are eligible to apply. Recipients will receive a registration to the Symposium (valued at \$250) plus \$1,000 to cover documented expenses (e.g., travel, lodging, meals, etc.). Reimbursements will be made at the conclusion of the Symposium.

Students wishing to apply for the scholarship are required to write an essay discussing why they want to attend the Symposium and how it will impact their future veterinary career. Essays must be between 500 and 750 words. ***Essays must be submitted to [info@abvp.com](mailto:info@abvp.com) by February 15, 2024, at 5:00 PM East Coast time.***

Please include the following information on all submissions:

- School you are attending
- Year in veterinary school
- Complete contact information

The ABVP Foundation Board will review the essays. Students will be notified of the outcome via e-mail. The decision of the Board is final and not subject to appeal. Successful students will be required to attend the 2024 ABVP Symposium. After the Symposium, the recipients must provide a brief report summarizing their experience, which might be used for advertisement purposes in future years.
