How long does it take to get approved?



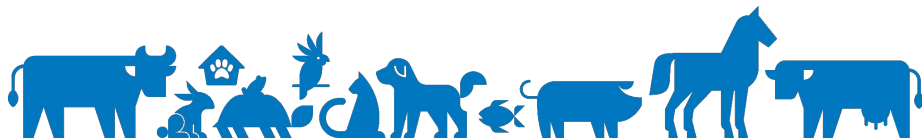
Be patient
